### Executive Rural Health

New leaders with new ideas keep policy and politics fresh and exciting. Yet, effective leaders don't just take root by themselves; they must be trained, informed, and nurtured. The Bighorn Program has been offering public policy training programs for eight years. The mission of the non-partisan Bighorn Leadership Development Program is:

*To ensure strong, effective, thoughtful public service and practical leadership is available to Colorado over the long term.*

Beginning in August, Bighorn will offer an "executive" program focusing on public policy development and advocacy with an emphasis on rural health. *Executive Rural Health* will be conducted over two weekends (a total of five total days) in Glenwood Springs, CO. Participants will have the chance learn more about political leadership and advocacy, policy development, and the ins and outs of politics and government, in order to make a difference in their local community and the state.

#### Course Dates and Locations

Friday, August 28<sup>th</sup> – Sunday, August 30<sup>th</sup> in Glenwood Springs AND  
Friday, October 9<sup>th</sup> – Saturday, October 10<sup>th</sup> in Glenwood Springs

**Cost** Participants pay \$300 in tuition (which includes meals and lodging), and agree to attend all five days of the course. The full cost of participation is subsidized by the generosity of The Colorado Trust.
